



Establishing a Team Learning Goal

Step 1: Identify a priority or goal area

- As a team read/review the [FAME Components & Elements](#) (Learning Guide pg. 11)
- Use a protocol for to identify what might be important to team member or what they might want to learn more about.
 - √ - I have learned about/I incorporate into my instruction
 - ! – This is important area for us to focus.
 - ? - I need to learn more about this
- As a team discuss thinking and identify an area that the team want to learn more about OR wants to focus on improving.

Step 2: Set a team goal

Goal Setting	What is your teams' goal? (get specific, utilize the Four Stages Table* or Indicators of Successful Practice* section in the FAME Learning Guide.)	
Progress Toward Goal	How will you know you are making progress toward your goal?	
Implementation	What might be the steps you will take to reach the goal?	
Celebration & Next Steps	How will you celebrate progress? How will you know you have been successful? How will you decide to continue with this goal or deepen your understanding in another area?
